

EOS Board Election - Jan Masajada



Jan Masajada is 54 years old and received his PhD degree from the Wrocław University of Science and Technology (WRUT) in Poland in the field of holography. He is currently a head of Singular Optics Group at the Department of Optics and Photonics, WRUT. In years 1992-95 he was a member of the team promoting security holograms in Poland (presently Hologram Industries Poland)

His research interests include a theory and applications of optical singularities (both phase and polarization) especially in the field of interferometry, optical manipulation and superresolution microscopy. He is a co-founder of Optical Tweezers Laboratory in WRUT.

He was a secretary of Optical Section of Polish Physical Society (affiliated member of EOS), secretary of Lower Silesian Chapter of Polish Physical Society (2012-2013), and member of Board of Lower Silesian Chapter of Polish Physical Society (2014-2015). He is a member of OSA.

Professor Masajada believes that a strong European Optical Society is essential for the future of European optics. If elected, he will campaign for wider interest in the EOS membership (and engagement in the EOS activity) among the professionals working in the field of optics and photonics and especially among the PhD students.
